Flu symptoms include:

- Fever (over 100 F), cough and or sore throat
- Runny nose, body aches, headache, chills, and low energy
- Diarrhea and vomiting may occur in some people

Instructions for care:

- It is important to check with your health care provider about any special care your child might need.
- Drink plenty of fluids.
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Get plenty of rest
- Please do not send your child to school while he/she is ill. Keep your child home from school for at least 24 hours after fever is gone.

Seek medical care immediately if your child has these warning signs:

- Fast breathing or trouble breathing
- Bluish skin color
- Not drinking enough fluids
- Not waking up or interacting
- Increased irritability
- Fever with rash
- Fever with worsening cough
